

#### 1.POWER SWITCH

Press the Power Switch ON/OFF into playing Electronic Keyboard Mode. (Picture 1)

#### 2.VOLUME

Press Volume+ (or -) to increase (decrease) the volume of Keyboard, The volume from range 00~16, 17 levels and default value is 12. (Picture 3)

## 3.TEMPO

Button Tempo+/- to speed up and down the tempo. (Picture 2)

#### 4.TONE CONTROL

- ◆Press Tone Button into mode Tone (left of LED light). (Picture 7 ) Select the tone by 0-9 from the Number Selection.
- ◆Default tone is C, Press Transpose+/- to Shift up/down the tone and show the transpose status from the LED display. (Picture 19)
- ◆Sustain

Press Button Sustain to start or stop Sustain function.

Under Sustain Mode will extension effect when playing keyboard. (Picture 16)

### 5.DEMO

Press DEMO (Picture 14), the keyboard will play the music from first (one by one ),press 0~9 or +/- of Number Selection to select what you want to play (Picture 12), Press DEOM again to stop playing.

#### **6.** PROG

Press [Prog] into Program Mode by playing Drum Combination, then press PLAY (Picture 4 )

## 7 .LESSON MODE

Follow:(Figure 13)

Press Lesson button into Lesson Mode, after the song played, the main melody is not set, the user must press the corresponding key according to the note displayed on the digital tube to continue playing the next one. The background sound is repeated to play the bar until the song is over. After the song is over, the same song can be continued to teach.

## 8. CHORD CONTROL

 ${\tt Press~CHORD~button~into~Chord~Mode}$ 

This button CHORD only takes place at the Rhythm and General Model In rhythm play mode, the user press the button and the key in the range of C3 F4#, after press Chord Finger, the user can hear the corresponding chord accompaniment. If not, it will stop and play single chord rhythm;

Chord can be used with rhythm/chord/synchronously. (Picture 18)

## **9.** RHYTHM

Press RHYTHM to enter into number selection to choose Rhythm. The input number is from 0 to 99. If the input range is not within this range, the input is invalid. (Picture 11)

## 10. RECORD

Press RECORD into recording Mode by playing Keyboard,(Picture 5) then press PLAY to play just record.(Picture 6)

#### **11**.DUAL KEYBOARD

- ◆.Dual Keyboard for on/off function. (Figure 9)
- ◆.Press the Dual Keyboard button, the keyboard on C3~C4 scale will correspond to C4~C5, on C5~C8 scale will correspond to C4~C7.
- ◆.Replace the original timbre of the C4~C7 keyboard by using number to select primary timbre.

#### 13. KEYBOARD LIGHT

This button can turn on/off the lights of white and black keyboard, the default is on. (Picture 10, LED 0N/0FF)

Teaching status can be exercised according to the light indication by default, press the button again to turn off the keyboard light.

#### 14 RHYTHM VOLUME

[Rhythm Vol] Button control is used to control the rhythm volume. Press [+] button, means turning up the volume. Press [-] button, means turning down the volume. There are 16 sections of the rhythm volume (1~16), the initial default volume is 12 after powering. Keep pressing Rhythm Volume [+] and [-], the volume will change to initial default volume. (Picture 20)

## 15. METRONOME

Press Metronome button into 4 change Beat sound, 1/4-2/4-3/4-4/4-STOP, Default Tempo is 120. (Picture 8)
